VI. MOY 2 (Middle Of Year) Results • Resultados de los exámenes de medio año (MOY 2)

THES benchmark results

reading & writing - we're doing well

math is a subject area that THES continues to work on

science - we're a top school in this content area; 3rd, 4th and 5th grade

Edith asks if our curriculum work made a difference in this. Lisa R. says not really.

Kinder, first & second grades are doing "running passages" with words and reading fluency; scores for 1st grade have decreased a bit, but the results are close

writing scores in kinder, first, second have been increasing in the past few months

Ramiro asks if you can track how a student will do in 5th grade based on their 4th grade scores?

Lisa R. says third grade will usually have lower scores because that's the student's first experience with tests *Implications & Plans*

kinder, first, second:

third, fourth, fifth

Blended learning: kinder TIMI has shown growth; first grade is making significant gains in math; first grade has had more online time with dreambox; nearly 50 percent of children are _____

5% --> 28% are now above grade level

goal of more than 90% on grade level

will follow up on dreambox at next meeting

VII. School breakfast universal plan • El plan de desayuno escolar universal

State Legislature passed SB 376

- 45.1 percent of low-income students participated in the free breakfast program at AISD school

- the percentage places AISD in the bottom 12 of the 63 districts studied nationally

- 63 of AISD SChool

Blake asks, "would providing a universal breakfast solve a problem that doesn't exist?"

Edith will ask Cris Carillo how changes would impact: as far as preparing food (quantities and menu items), etc.

VIII. Expeditionary Learning update • Noticias de Expeditionary Learning

Where we are in the process.

Lisa R.: we have access to EL. learning target & service learning is aligned with expeditionary learning targets We're continuing with the partnership, financially and support-wise. Teachers that have been trained on expeditions are presenting and sharing with teachers. Prek was learning about recycling; are working on next steps and including expeditionary learning in planning.

Would be good to begin annual meetings or reports. Alex: Ed Austin is willing to sit down with Thunderboard members and other relevant parties to talk about "business package" to present to others about what is THES charter, what do we do, what does it mean. Melanie: Karen Burnstein is working on a branding video "Travis Heights is Austin." Three day filming will be on the books in April (after STAAR).

Betty: we used to put out a quarterly newsletter. Written, printed and distributed with the neighborhood association newsletter.

Lisa & Betty will sit down and discuss ideas for an "encyclopedic" report to share about what it means to be a charter.

Britt will write up what the Thunderboard has done.

Blake will talk to PTA board.
