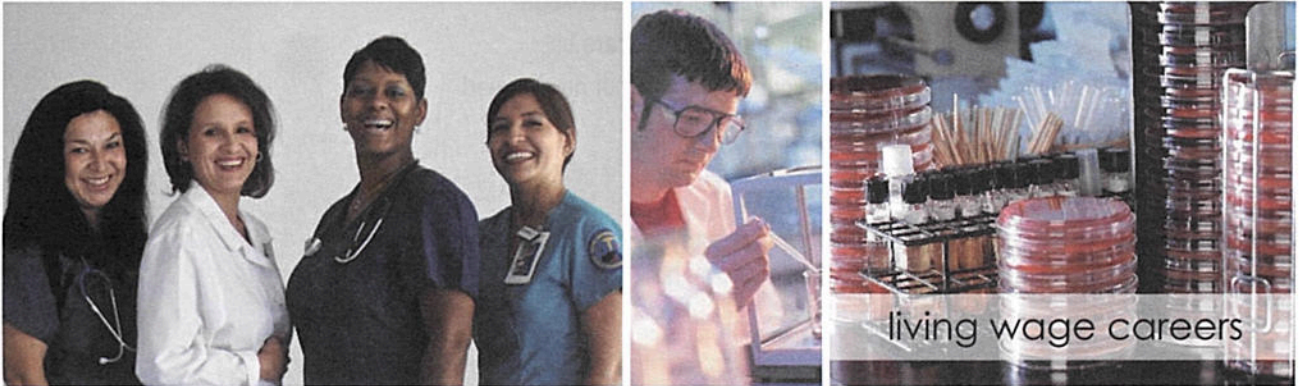

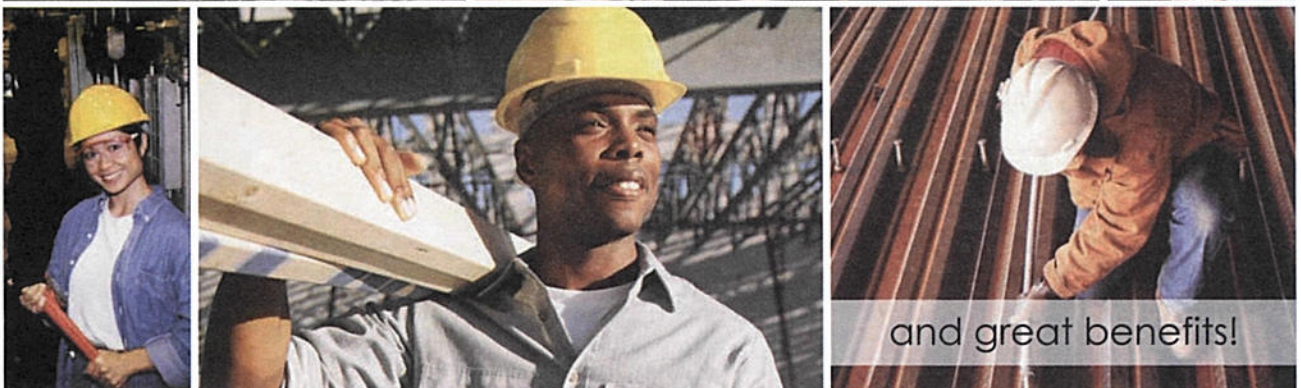

### Basic Qualifications

- Adults only - must be over 18 years of age, no maximum age limit.
- Low income (see chart)
- Live in Travis County
- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Do NOT have a college degree (associate's degree or higher)
- US Citizen or Permanent Resident
