How can you tell if your wound is infected?

- Usually is evident within two days after injury or suturing
- All need to be evaluated by a physician if symptoms occur

Symptoms include:

- Redness
- Pus discharge
- Swelling
- Worsening pain

Treatments include:

- Antibiotics
- Possible drainage or debridement
